The 443.575 repeater is in Wesley Chapel.

The 443.600 repeater is located at St. Leo University.

We are also linked to the 441.425 ZAARC W1PB in Zephyrhills.

The Fusion repeaters are linked by Wires-X using the "Florida WCF" room number, 81609. All the repeaters use a C.T.C.S.S. tone of 146.2

We also have a digital net on Thursdays at 8PM. If you have a Fusion radio, please feel free to join us and use the full features of the FUSION system.

The Club also has a G-M-R-S Repeater in Wesley Chapel on 462.650, the repeater has a C.T.C.S.S. tone of 118.8
