The Club's 70 Centimeter repeaters are YAESU FUSION Digital.

The Fusion repeaters are linked to Wires-X using room number, 81609.

The Club also has a G-M-R-S Repeater in Wesley Chapel.

Your name,

Your call sign,

and your QTH.

You can follow along using "Net Logger"

(SLOW DOWN) THERE IS A DELAY.

This is an informal "Rag Chew" net after the first round of check ins, we will come back around, and you can let us know what is on your mind.

NET CONTROL OPERATOR (SLOW DOWN) REMEMBER THERE IS A 2-SECOND DELAY IN DIGITAL MODE.

Let's take our check-ins.

Stations, please call Net Control.

After all remote stations have checked in then move to call local stations.

We will now take our local check-ins.

Stations with suffix ALPHA through Mike please call Net Control, Calling A-M.

(SLOW DOWN) THERE IS A DELAY.

Stations with suffix NOVEMBER through ZULU please call Net Control, Calling N-Z.

When all check-ins are completed then move to the net closing.
